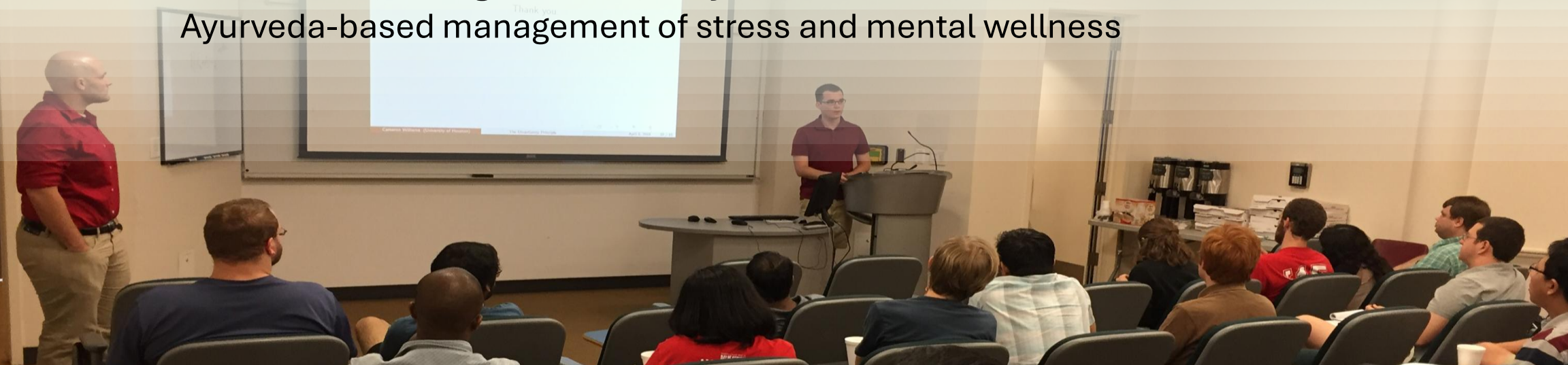

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

AYURSAMAGRA 2026 invites abstracts from **Ayurveda practitioners, academicians, researchers, scientists, PG/PhD scholars, students, and industry professionals** for **oral and poster presentations**. Submissions may include **original research, review articles, clinical case studies, conceptual papers, technological innovations, and evidence-based practices** aligned with the conference themes. Abstracts should be written in **English**, not exceeding **300 words**, and must include the **title, author(s) name and affiliation, background, objectives, methods, results, and conclusion**, along with **3–5 keywords**. Authors are required to clearly indicate the **presentation category (paper/poster)** and the **relevant theme** at the time of submission.

All submitted abstracts will undergo review by the **Scientific Committee**, and selected submissions will be notified via email. Ethical clearance should be mentioned for clinical studies wherever applicable. Accepted abstracts will be included in the **Conference Souvenir / Abstract Book**, and **certificates of presentation** will be awarded to presenters.

E-Poster design specifications:

Poster size and orientation: All posters will be set in portrait-style orientation.

All information (i.e. text, data, photos, and figures) must be designed to fit within one page of above said specifications.

If E-Poster is prepared in PowerPoint (PPT), customize the slide by using Page Setup and choose Slide Size: “Custom (Width 50 cm, Height 90 cm)” with a Portrait (vertical) orientation.

The resolution of the monitors used for e-poster presentation is 1920 x 1080 pixels and the size is 52,3 cm x 93,3 cm (in Portrait orientation).

*At least **one author must be registered** for the conference to present the paper or poster.*

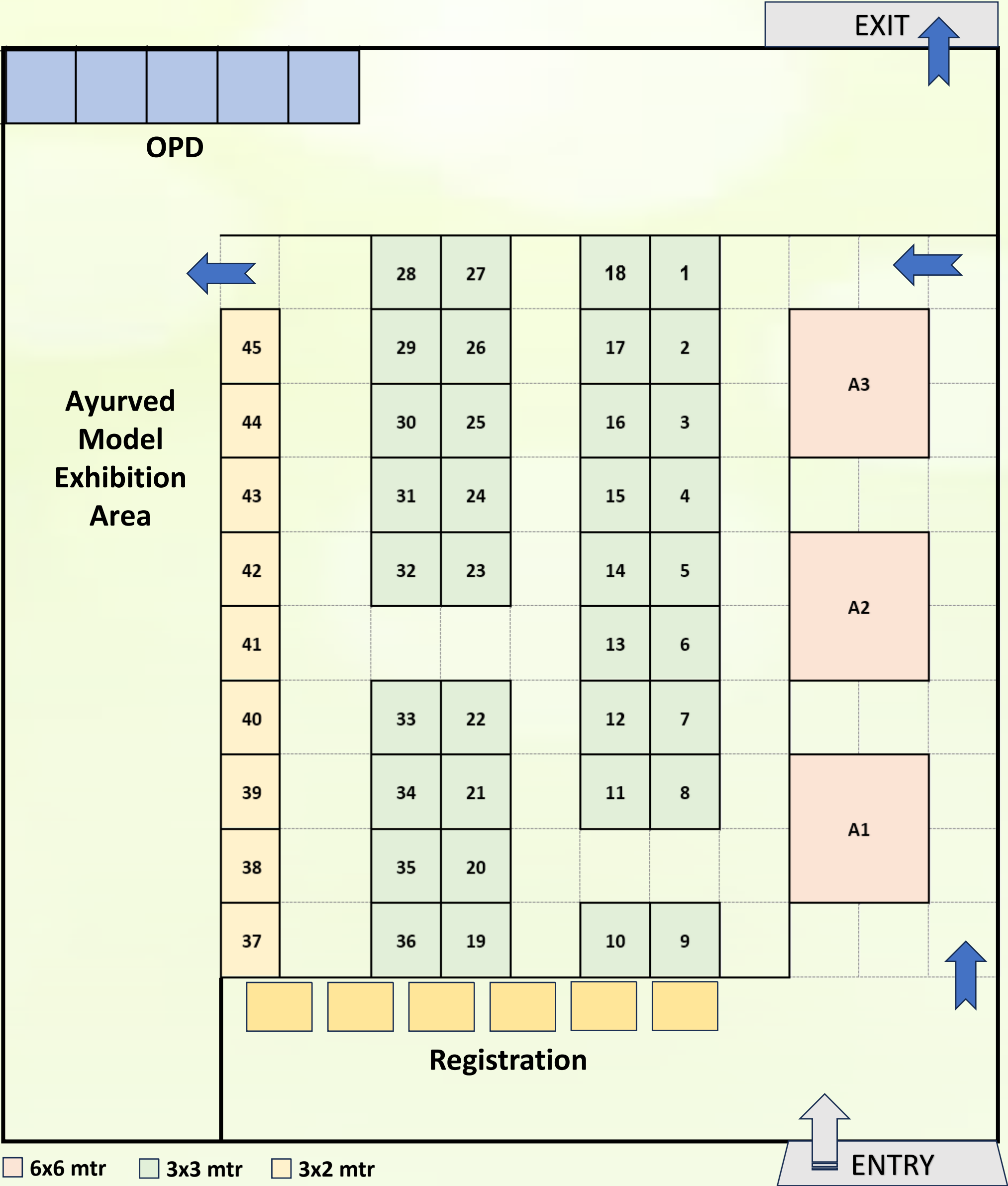
